"Bridge Builders" Message from the Pastor

Grace, Mercy, and Peace be unto you from God our Father, and Jesus our Lord and Savior.

I greet you with the Joy of Jesus as we enter the fourth month of the year, April. We've heard the phrase; "April showers bring May flowers". This phrase conveys the message of rainwater falling on soil and seed will activate and produce the beautiful flowers of Spring. In the spirit, this same principle applies. 
