Message from the Pastor



Grace, mercy, and peace be unto you from God our Father and Jesus our Lord and Savior.

I greet you with the joy of Jesus as we celebrate the final month of the year, December. This is the season of Advent, and we eagerly anticipate the promised Messiah. In the words of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, "The celebration of Advent is possible only to those who are troubled in soul, who know themselves to be poor and imperfect, and who look forward to something greater to come."

The word "Advent" is derived from the Latin word *adventus*, meaning "coming," which translates to the Greek word *parousia*. Scholars believe that during the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> centuries in Spain and Gaul, Advent was a season of preparation for the baptism of new Christians at the January feast of Epiphany, the celebration of God's incarnation represented by the visit

of the Magi to the baby Jesus, His baptism in the Jordan River by John the Baptist, and His first miracle at Cana. During this season of preparation, Christians would spend 40 days in penance, prayer, and fasting to prepare for this celebration; originally, there was little connection between Advent and Christmas. By the sixth century, however, Roman Christians had tied Advent to the coming of Christ. But the "coming" they had in mind was not Christ's first coming in the manger in Bethlehem, but his second coming in the clouds as the judge of the world.

Advent symbolizes the present situation of the church in these "last days" as God's people wait for the return of Christ in glory to consummate his eternal kingdom. The church is like Israel at the end of the Old Testament: in exile, waiting and hoping in prayerful expectation for the coming of the Messiah. Israel looked back to God's past gracious actions on their behalf in leading them out of Egypt in the Exodus, and on this basis, they called for God once again to act for them.

In the same way, the church, during Advent, looks back upon Christ's coming in celebration while at the same time looking forward in eager anticipation to the coming of Christ's kingdom when he returns for his people. Let us celebrate all that God has done for us this year and look forward to a new year full of God's opportunities and winning strategies.

Enjoy time with family and friends, strengthening relationships and valuing the things that matter most. Let us also recommit ourselves to kingdom work, being intentional about our mission and objectives. We have been chosen for such a time as this to make kingdom impact in the world, and with God's help we will accomplish all we have been purposed to do.

I would like to take this opportunity to personally thank each of you for your service and sacrifices through ministry at New Hope. You have helped advance the kingdom by your dedication and Love. May God richly bless each of you. Merry Christmas!


