As we enjoy the warmth of Summer, and the sun's rays lengthens the days, it seems as if time is flying by. Therefore, we must live life to the fullest and maximize the time we have been given. The month of July for Americans includes Independence Day. Also known as July 4th, it commemorates the ratification of the Declaration of Independence by the second Continental Congress on July 4th 1776, establishing the United States of America. While many will celebrate across the country in activities in honor of liberty and freedom, another group of citizens is experiencing a different reality. Many are afraid of being snatched off the streets by ICE, others are afraid that their Medicaid will be cut, or food stamps will be eliminated. It is difficult to feel that liberty and justice for all is actualized in our society. For the believer, our freedom has been secured by Jesus Christ. Jesus' death broke the chains of sin, freeing us from it's penalty, giving us a right to the tree of life. He who ever the son sets free is free indeed. While we are free from the penalty of sin, but we are also saved from the vices of this world. Our peace then comes from God and that peace passes all understanding. That peace is particularly needed now, considering the state of the union. I am reminded of a devotion I read last year that I believe will help our hope and fuel our faith. Dated July 25th 2024, it's titled *July Devotional* by Jeanine Michaels.

*2 Chronicles 20:12- "O our God, will You not judge them? For we have no power against this great multitude that is coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are upon you. Poll anyone in our country and ask them how they think we, as a nation, are doing. It doesn't matter the political persuasion of whomever you ask, the answers will be the same. This country is in trouble.*

*From our national debt to our national sin, removing God, prayer and the Bible from almost every vestige of our society, the lack of common sense, and the lunacy of the hills people choose to die on, one thing is clear. We NEED Jesus!*

*In 2 Chronicles 20, we find this gem of a verse that may be something to memorize. You see, the people of Judah were in a bad situation. They were embroiled in a war with many enemies joining forces to come against them. In verse 3, Jehoshaphat feared and set himself to seek the Lord, and proclaimed a fast throughout all the land. They were about to be dispossessed from the land. Jehoshaphat prays a beautiful prayer (Check out 2 Chronicles 20 to read more.) And he ends his prayer by acknowledging a very simple, yet profound, fact. We have no power against this multitude that is coming against us; nor do we know what to do... Does this not summarize how we feel so much of the time?! A multitude comes against us daily. We don't know what to do. But our eyes are upon You. This is the answer. This is the brilliant solution! All we have to do is keep our eyes on Jesus! He is our shield and defense. He is our rock and our mighty fortress. And best of all, He is our deliverer.*

*Do you remember the story of Peter walking on the water with Jesus? Peter had to learn this same principle when he stepped out of the boat. All he had to do was keep his eyes upon His Savior. He didn't know what to do. So, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" No time for an eloquent prayer. If he had only kept his eyes on Jesus instead of allowing his circumstances to distract him, he could have walked on the water a little longer. Where are your eyes focused? Friend, keep them upon the Lord! Especially when we don't know what to do.*

*I pray this devotional has reminded you of the importance of keeping your eyes on Jesus, trusting that He will see you through. May God bless you and keep you in His care.*

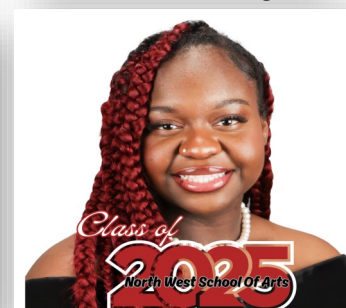
