"Bridge Builders" Message from the Pastor

Grace, mercy, and peace be unto you from God our Father and Jesus our Lord and Savior.

I greet you with the joy of Jesus as we enter this third month of the year. We are in Lent and making our journey toward the cross and resurrection. Campus Crusade for Christ International shares these points about Lent. The three main things people focus on during Lent are prayer, fasting (abstaining from something to reduce distractions and focus more on God) and giving, or charity.

- Prayer during Lent focuses on our need for God's forgiveness. It is also about repenting (turning away from our sins) and receiving God's mercy and love.
- Fasting, or giving something up, is a common practice during Lent. The idea is that giving up something that is a regular part of life, like eating dessert or scrolling through Facebook, can be a reminder of Jesus' sacrifice. That time can also be replaced with more time connecting with God.
- Giving money or doing something good for others is a way to respond to God's grace, generosity, and love. For example, some people spend time volunteering or donate money they would normally use to buy something, like their morning coffee.

It is important to note that doing these things can never make us earn or deserve Jesus' sacrifice or a relationship with God. People are flawed and will never be good enough for a perfect God. Only Jesus has the power to rescue us from ourselves. Jesus sacrificed Himself on Good Friday to bear the punishment for all our wrongdoings and offer us forgiveness. He was raised from the dead, on Easter Sunday to give us an opportunity to have a relationship with God for eternity.

Spending time during Lent praying, fasting, and giving can make Jesus' sacrifice on Good Friday and His resurrection on Easter even more meaningful. We thank God for the ultimate sacrifice of His Son, Jesus Christ but we also must not forget that we too must be willing to be offered as living sacrifices. As we present ourselves to God we are then used in other capacities and area that have the ability to promote change and transformation throughout our communities and the world.

Our ancestors and fore mothers and fathers sacrificed blood, sweat, tears, and their lives to make life better for the generations after them, for freedom, equal rights, a vote, a voice, and a place. We should remember as we move closer to the victory of the third day that without sacrifice, which would not have ended good for us. Let us continue maximizing this moment until all are free.


