Message from the Pastor

Grace, mercy, and peace be unto you from God our Father and Jesus our Lord and Savior.

I excitedly greet you with the joy of Jesus as we enter into the 10th month or the year. We have entered into harvest time. I share words from a blogger of world vision regarding harvest. Jesus refers to God as "the Lord of the harvest" (Matthew 9:38). How do you reflect God's bounty in your everyday life? The symbolic meaning of harvest in Scripture encompasses two main areas: God's provision for us and God's blessing for others.

While we celebrate a harvest season just once a year, we experience the spirit of harvest all the time. Each day that we go to a job and earn a paycheck, we experience harvest. Each time we receive love from our family and those in our lives, we experience harvest. Each time we experience the closeness of God in a way that fills us spiritually, we experience harvest. Any time we are filled, we experience harvest.

Harvest then isn't something that we experience once a year, but something that we experience on a daily basis. This is where those words Jesus uses are so important: The harvests we experience on a daily basis don't actually belong to us — they belong to God, because he is the Lord of the harvest, not us. Our jobs belong to the Lord of the harvest. The money we earn belongs to the Lord of the harvest. Our spouses and children belong to the Lord of the harvest. It's all his. We recognize that he is the one who gave us hands to work, that he is the one who supplies our provisions, that our family is actually his family ... that it rightfully belongs to him.

Finally, when we recognize the Lord of the harvest for who he is in our lives, we also embrace the fact that while in part our harvest is something he gives to meet our needs, it's also something he wants us to use to bless others. All those wonderful things in our lives that we'll give thanks for next month? Those things exist, in large part, to be a blessing to the world around us. We also acknowledge breast cancer awareness and pray for those littering with, fighting through, who've overcome breast cancer, and we remember the lives of those lost from that dreaded disease. We also acknowledge domestic violence and raise the consciousness of people across this country that domestic violence is real, And must not be tolerated.

As we enjoy harvest, we also have a responsibility to combat issues that threaten the fullness of harvest in the lives of God's children. Let us do all we can to make a harvest not only a spiritual reality, but a tangible one as well. On the third Sunday we acknowledge our mission Sunday, and the wonderful ministry our mission department provides all year long. On the third Sunday and mission department will conduct a worship, and we are excited and expected that God will move in a mighty way. This month is the annual session of the General Baptist State Convention of North Carolina Inc. and it is an election year, hosted in Wilmington, NC.




